2005 Agency-Request Legislation

Three agency-request bills were considered and two were passed by the 2005 Legislature and signed by the Governor.

SB 5039 Milk and Milk Products [Detailed Summary](#) [Bill Information page for SB 5039](#)

- Eliminates the requirement that capping of milk and milk products be done with mechanical equipment.
- Clarifies licensing requirements for companies that process both milk and milk products and other food products.
- Increases the annual license fee for a milk processing plant from \$25 to \$55 to be consistent with the license fee of small-scale food processing plants.

HB 1086 Commercial Feed [Detailed Summary](#) [Bill Information page for HB 1086](#)

- Changes the pet food registration period from a one-year to a two-year registration period.
- Clarifies reporting requirements and inspection fee payment responsibilities for all licensees and registrants.

SB 5602 Livestock Nutrient Management [Bill information page for SB 5602](#)

Substitute SB 5602 was signed into law but does not contain the provisions included in the original bill which was agency-request legislation designed to update the Dairy Nutrient Management Act and provide statutory authority for WSDA to carry out the program that meets the minimum requirements for EPA's Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO) rule.
