

KRS On-Line Renewal Option Available for Washington

The Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) is offering registrants the ability to renew their currently registered products online using the Kelly Registration Systems (KRS). A convenience fee of \$10 per product is charged by KRS to use this service in Washington. WSDA will accept the submission of revised e-labels in PDF format during the renewal period when they use this option to reregister pesticide products in Washington. Registrants can still submit two copies of revised labeling to WSDA via regular mail at any time.

KRS will send the other required renewal items on behalf of those companies who choose to use e-Renewals option directly to WSDA. Use of e-Renewals for the 2009-2010 cycle and submission of revised e-labels is allowed only if the following conditions are met:

- The appropriate Re-Registration fee (e.g. \$390/product) must be paid by KRS to WSDA by check only. Registrants submit the original registration fee directly to KRS.
- WSDA receives a complete Application for Re-Registration of Pesticides for each company with an electronic signature.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - SUBMISSION OF REVISED ELECTRONIC LABELS ONLY

WSDA reserves the right to refuse invalid revised labels, which needlessly increase review time. Invalid labels includes illegible, incomplete, and/or identical to those already on file. To avoid this problem, registrants should:

- Review the list of products registered in Washington, and
- Check the label identification code before uploading revised labels to KRS website.
